"Further to the email sent to the Bishop of London by [REDACTED] on 1st March 2019 and copied to you, please note that this contains a range of allegations which are unsubstantiated, some of which are currently subject to the Church of England's Clergy Disciplinary Measure. Please do note the confidentiality of this process and ensure these emails are not forwarded to any other individual. We are currently liaising with the sender's legal advisors in connection with this matter".

[REDACTED] a complaint under the Clergy Discipline Measure 2003 has been filed with the support of solicitors by one of the Vulnerable Adult residents of the City of London Ward of Portsoken who experienced sexual abuse, stalking and harassment from Campbell-Taylor, and sent in the first instance to the Bishop of London.

There are other concurrent complaints under the Clergy Discipline Measure against Campbell-Taylor that are to follow shortly.

In the meantime, Campbell-Taylor has responded by causing one of his close colleagues and friends, [REDACTED]

in the Diocese of London, to apply political pressure upon trustees of faith-based charities in which I am an Officer.

This is a classic Campbell-Taylor political bullying and harassment tactic, and I am advised that there have been other cases of complaints under the Clergy Discipline Measure by other complainants in which [REDACTED] has interfered in the process despite it having nothing to do with him.

The Diocese of London claims it tells the truth and claims that it will handle Safeguarding concerns and CDM complaints fairly.
